

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Certifying Councilwoman Barbara Salvicio as Vice Chairwoman of the Health and Human Services Committee)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 02-475

1 **WHEREAS, on September 9, 2002 Legislative Council Chairwoman Rita Martinez did receive the**
2 **resignation of Gu Achi District Representative to the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
3 **Council Alex J. Ramon, which was effective October 4, 2002; and**

4 **WHEREAS, prior to his resignation, Councilman Ramon served on the Legislative Council Health**
5 **and Human Services Committee; and**

6 **WHEREAS, Councilman Ramon was elected to the Vice Chairmanship of the Health and Human**
7 **Services Committee; that office became vacant due to his resignation; and**

8 **WHEREAS, individual Legislative Committees are empowered to caucus and elect Legislative**
9 **Committee Officers (Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council,**
10 **Article XII, Section 3.J.); and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee did caucus on October 9, 2002 and elected**
12 **Councilwoman Barbara Salvicio as Vice Chairwoman.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
14 **certifies Councilwoman Barbara Salvicio as Vice Chairwoman of the Health and**
15 **Human Services Committee.**

16 **BE IT FINALLY ORDERED that Legislative Order No. 01-300 (Certifying Legislative Committee**
17 **Officers) is hereby superceded only to the extent that Councilwoman Barbara Salvicio**
18 **is appointed as the Health and Human Services Committee Vice Chairwoman.**

19 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH. Day of**
20 **OCTOBER 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
21 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [-0-] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) &**
22 **(b) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
23 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
24 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
25 **Stat. 984).**
