


**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the continued use of the Hickiwan District \$500,000.00 Supplemental
Funds and Extension of Fiscal Year to October 2002 through September 2003)**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-480

1 **WHEREAS, the Hickiwan District held a special meeting on October 08, 2002; and**
2 **WHEREAS, the (11) Districts requested supplemental funds from the Tohono O'odham Nation in**
3 **the amount of \$500,000.00 per (11) District in FY 2002; and**
4 **WHEREAS, the Hickiwan District Council in discussion of the FY 2003 Budget also discussed the**
5 **remaining amount of the \$500,000.00 supplemental funds which is in the amount of**
6 **\$101,256.86; and**
7 **WHEREAS, the Hickiwan District Council requests that the remainder of the supplemental funds**
8 **which totals \$101,256.86 be utilized to fund (5) labor positions, fringe benefits and**
9 **that the remaining sum will be placed in the materials line item; and**
10 **WHEREAS, the Hickiwan District Council sees the need to the continued use of the supplemental**
11 **funds for the benefit and assistance to members of the Hickiwan District; and**
12 **WHEREAS, the Hickiwan District Council does support the fiscal year extension to October 2002**
13 **through September 2003 to use the remaining funds, to be placed in the Wachovia**
14 **Securities for the Hickiwan District in a separate account from the FY 2003 budget of**
15 **the Hickiwan District.**
16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
17 **the continued use of the remaining funds of the \$500,000.00 supplemental in the**
18 **amount of \$101,256.86 which will be held in a separate account in the Wachovia**
19 **Securities for the Hickiwan District.**
20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the extension**
21 **of the supplemental funds fiscal year to October 2002 through September 2003.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH Day**
23 **of OCTOBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-**
24 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
25 **1 (d)(2)&(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
26 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
27 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
28 **Stat. 984).**


