7	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Legislative Order No. 01-447, the Legislative Officers are delegated
8		$authority to \verb§"[a]]{llocate funds}, \verb§staff§, \verb§and other resources for the effective operation of$
9		the Legislative Branch" and to "[a]pprove Legislative Branch expenditures"; and
10	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council and Branch staff are often required to travel off the Nation
11		${\bf and\ outside\ the\ State\ of\ Arizona\ to\ participate\ in\ national-level\ meetings, coordinate}$

14	WHEREAS,	$such \ travel\ requires\ the\ allocation\ of\ vehicles, staff\ time, and\ other\ resources\ as\ well$

16	WHEREAS,	travel should be authorized and funded in a manner which holds travelers
17		accountable and serves the Tohono O'odham, but that does not prevent the Council
18		committees from accomplishing their work or achieving quorums; and
19	WHEREAS,	in  an  effort  to  address  concerns  over  the  amount  and  necessity  of  Legislative  Branch
20		travel, the Legislative Council previously adopted an "Internal Legislative Branch
21		Travel Policy" (Legislative Order No. 96-133); and
22	WHEREAS,	the Internal Policy was subsequently amended and replaced by the "Legislative
23		Branch Travel Policy," which reduced the number of Council representatives from
24		a  single  committee  who  were  authorized  to  travel  at  the  same  time  (Legislative  Order  travel  at  the  same  time  (Legislative  Order  travel  tr
25		No. 98-144); and
26	WHEREAS,	it is in the best interest of the Legislative Branch and the members of the Tohono
27		O'odham Nation that the existing Travel Policy be updated and revised; and
28	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Officers have developed the attached "Revised Legislative Branch
29		Travel Policy," which is incorporated by this reference, to increase fiscal
30		responsibility when utilizing Legislative Branch travel funds and to ensure that
