1	WHEREAS,	the Data Improvement Assessment performed for the Tohono O'odham Nation by a
2		team from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) in October
3		2001 identified the need to aggregate available data into a uniform and useable
4		database to identify planning problems and to mobilize resources for maintenance,
5		construction and public safety agencies; and
6	WHEREAS,	the Nation's Planning Department is in the process of creating a Geographic
7		Information Systems database for the three reservations that comprise the Nation's
8		lands, which will include a road inventory update of road geometry, condition, and
9		traffic; and
10	WHEREAS,	the Nation's Police Department includes a traffic records division that puts crash
11		reports in a Microsoft Access database and passes these records on to outside
12		agencies such as the Arizona Department of Transportation and the Indian Health
13		Service so that they may better serve the Nation's lands; and
14	WHEREAS,	the NHTSA Assessment identified the disconnect between the Planning Department's
15		database and the Police Department's database as a barrier to effective use of crash
16		data; and
17	WHEREAS,	combining crash data provided with the Police Department with Planning's
18		geographic database will allow the Nation and the outside agencies that serve the
19		Nation's lands to use this data more effectively; and
20	WHEREAS,	NHTSA, through the Bureau of Indian Affairs Indian Highway Safety program, has
21		made \$107,440 available for fiscal year 2002 to improve traffic records on tribal lands
22		towards the establishment and maintenance of a nationwide Tribal Traffic Records
23		System by the end of calendar year 2004; and
24	WHEREAS,	the Planning Department has applied for and been given tentative approval for
25		\$17,349.50 from these funds to incorporate crash data in a roadway information
26		database to facilitate highway safety analysis for future planning and programming
27		of maintenance and construction.
28	NOW, THE	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the attached grant application for traffic records
29		improvement is hereby approved by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
