

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving District Water Advisory Committee Budget for Fiscal Year 2003)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-495

1 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 02-492, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council adopted Bylaws**
2 **which established the District Water Advisory Committee (the "Advisory Committee");**
3 **and**

4 **WHEREAS, funding is necessary to enable the Advisory Committee to satisfy the responsibilities**
5 **assigned in the Bylaws; and**

6 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 309(a) of the Southern Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act of**
7 **1982 ("SAWRSA"), the Tohono O'odham Nation (the "Nation") received \$15,000,000 to**
8 **be held in trust by the Nation (the "SAWRSA Trust Fund"); and**

9 **WHEREAS, under Section 309(b) of SAWRSA, the Nation may expend accrued interest and**
10 **dividends on the SAWRSA Trust Fund "for the subjugation of land, development of**
11 **water resources, and the construction, operation, maintenance, and replacement of**
12 **related facilities on the Papago Reservation (now known as the Tohono O'odham**
13 **Reservation) which are not the obligation of the United States under this (SAWRSA) or**
14 **any other Act of Congress"; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the responsibilities of the Advisory Committee related to development of water**
16 **resources qualify for funding under the SAWRSA Trust Fund; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Advisory Committee has prepared the attached budget for fiscal year 2003 in the**
18 **amount of \$121,250 and funded from the SAWRSA Trust Fund; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Committee and Budget & Finance Committee recommended**
20 **approval by the Legislative Council of the Advisory Committee budget for fiscal year**
21 **2003.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

23 **1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves the District Water**
24 **Advisory Committee budget in the amount of \$121,250 for fiscal year 2003, in the**
25 **form attached hereto.**

26 **2. The Legislative Council appropriates the sum of \$121,250 from the SAWRSA Trust**
27 **Fund to fund the District Water Advisory Committee budget for fiscal year 2003.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH Day**
29 **of OCTOBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,216.9 FOR; 562.05**
30 **AGAINST; 638.55 NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
31 **Section 1 (d)(2)&(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
32 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
33 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
34 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


