

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Endorsement of Janet Napolitano for Governor of Arizona)**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-500

1 **WHEREAS, Janet Napolitano is the Democratic candidate for Arizona State Governor; and**  
2 **WHEREAS, throughout her career as a U.S. Attorney for Arizona and as State of Arizona Attorney**  
3 **General, Janet Napolitano has consistently maintained her support for the**  
4 **continuation of Indian sovereignty and Tribal rights, and supported the Tohono**  
5 **O'odham Nation; and**  
6 **WHEREAS, as U.S. Attorney, Janet Napolitano sought to protect Tohono O'odham cultural, and**  
7 **spiritual values during investigations that required autopsies; and**  
8 **WHEREAS, as State of Arizona Attorney General, Ms. Napolitano supported bi-lingual**  
9 **education for American Indians in Arizona, and sought to improve the disposition of**  
10 **Indian Child Welfare Act cases to better protect the interests of Tribes and children;**  
11 **and**  
12 **WHEREAS, as a gubernatorial candidate, Ms. Napolitano supports continued, limited casino**  
13 **gaming by Arizona's Indian tribes as a means to promote tribal economic**  
14 **development and self-sufficiency, and supports Proposition 202, the 17-Tribe Gaming**  
15 **Initiative; and**  
16 **WHEREAS, Ms. Napolitano also has gone on record to protect Tribal interests in water by**  
17 **encouraging fair and equitable settlements of claims.**  
18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council strongly**  
19 **supports and endorses the candidacy of Janet Napolitano for the Governor of the**  
20 **State of Arizona.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
23 **of OCTOBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,893.2 FOR; -0-**  
24 **AGAINST; 363.6 NOT VOTING; and 160.7 [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**  
25 **by Section 1 (l) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
26 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
27 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
28 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




