

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of FY 2003 Title VI, Part A Budget Amendment #2)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-515

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully operated a program for the Elders of the**
2 **Nation; and**

3 **WHEREAS, funding for the operation of the Senior Services Program has been made possible in**
4 **part by Title VI of the Older American's Act of 1978 as amended; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Title VI Program Budget Part A has been awarded a one time supplement of**
6 **\$3,250 as stated in the attached Award Document Letter; and**

7 **WHEREAS, Title VI Program Budget Part-A Amendment #2 has been prepared to increase funds**
8 **from \$132,850 to \$136,100 utilizing the one time supplement of \$3,250.**

9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
10 **approves:**

11 **1. The FY 2003 Title VI, Part A Budget Amendment #2 to increase the funds from**
12 **\$132,850 to \$136,100 utilizing the one time supplement of \$3,250 as reflected in**
13 **the attached budget.**

14 **2. The Tohono O'odham Nation officials, to wit: The Chairman is authorized to**
15 **negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any amendments**
16 **affecting the funding or funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for**
17 **further prior approval by this Council.**

18 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04TH Day**
19 **of NOVEMBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,229.2 FOR; -0-**
20 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 188.3 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
21 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
22 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
23 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
24 **Stat. 984).**
