5	WHEREAS,	the Title VI Program Budget Part A has been awarded a one time supplement of							
6		\$3,250 as stated in the attached Award Document Letter; and							
7	WHEREAS,	Title VI Program Budget Part-A Amendment #2 has been prepared to increase funds							
8		from \$132,850 to \$136,100 utilizing the one time supplement of \$3,250.							
9	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby								
10		approves:							
11		1. The FY 2003 Title VI, Part A Budget Amendment #2 to increase the funds from							
12		\$132,850 to \$136,100 utilizing the one time supplement of \$3,250 as reflected in							
13		the attached budget.							
14		2. The Tohono O'odham Nation officials, to wit: The Chairman is authorized to							
15		negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any amendments							
16		affecting the funding or funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for							
17		further prior approval by this Council.
