

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving an Attorney Contract with California Indian Legal Services)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-519

1 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Legislative Council Resolutions 01-530 and 02-017, the Nation entered**
2 **into an Attorney Contract with California Indian Legal Services (the "Attorneys") for**
3 **Fiscal Year 2002, for the purpose of providing legal representation to protect the**
4 **Nation's interests under the Indian Child Welfare Act in connection with legal**
5 **proceedings in the State of California; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract expired on September 30, 2002; and**

7 **WHEREAS, continued representation is necessary to protect the Nation's interests in these**
8 **proceedings; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Operating Budget for the Office of Attorney General for Fiscal Year 2003, approved**
10 **by the Legislative Council in Resolution No. 02-427, has sufficient funds for an**
11 **attorney contract in the amount of \$66,000.00 for representation in these**
12 **proceedings; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Attorney General has proposed an attorney contract with California Indian Legal**
14 **Services, in the amount of \$66,000.00, a copy of which is attached hereto; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee recommends approval by the Legislative Council of**
16 **an Attorney Contract with the Attorneys on such terms.**

17 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

- 18 **1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves an Attorney Contract**
19 **with California Indian Legal Services in the amount of \$66,000 for the fiscal year**
20 **ending September 30, 2003, and in the form attached hereto.**
- 21 **2. Funding for the Attorney Contract shall be provided under the authority of**
22 **Resolution No. 02-427 in the operating budget for the Office of Attorney General.**
- 23 **3. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute the Attorney**
24 **Contract.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH Day**
26 **of NOVEMBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,084.7 FOR; -0-**
27 **AGAINST; 144.5 NOT VOTING; and 188.3 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
28 **by Section 2 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
29 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


