

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving Attorney Contract with Slosser, Hudgins, Struse & Freund)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 02-522**

1 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Legislative Council Resolution 02-020, the Nation entered into an**  
2 **Attorney Contract with Slosser, Hudgins, Struse & Freund (the "Attorneys") for the**  
3 **purpose of providing legal representation to the Nation with respect to the tax**  
4 **implications for the Nation and its members associated with the implementation of**  
5 **an Initiative (No. IN-01-97) approved by the voters of the Nation on June 28, 1997; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract was in the amount of \$12,500 for the period from October 1,**  
7 **2001 through September 30, 2002; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract expired on September 30, 2002; and**

9 **WHEREAS, continued representation is necessary to protect the Nation's interests in these**  
10 **matters; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Attorney General has proposed an Attorney Contract with the Attorneys for fiscal**  
12 **year 2003 in the amount of \$12,500; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the fiscal year 2003 budget for Initiative Legal Research (24-1809-810) approved by the**  
14 **Legislative Council has sufficient funds for an Attorney Contract in the amount of**  
15 **\$12,500; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee recommends approval by the Legislative Council of**  
17 **the Attorney Contract.**


18 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

- 19           **1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves an Attorney Contract**  
20           **with Slosser, Hudgins, Struse & Freund for fiscal year 2003 in the amount of**  
21           **\$12,500 and in the form attached hereto.**
- 22           **2. Funding for the Attorney Contract shall be provided from the Initiative Legal**  
23           **Research budget (24-1809-810) for fiscal year 2003.**
- 24           **3. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute the Attorney**  
25           **Contract.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06<sup>TH</sup>. Day**  
27 **of NOVEMBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,813.1 FOR; 416.1**  
28 **AGAINST; 188.3 NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
29 **Section 2 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
30 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
31 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
32 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


