

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving an Attorney Contract with the Law Firm of Williams & Works, P.A.)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 02-523**

1 **WHEREAS, by Resolution Nos. 01-533, 02-021 and 02-342, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**  
2 **approved an Attorney Contract with the law firm of Williams & Works, P.A. (formerly**  
3 **known as the law firm of Williams, Janov & Cooney) (the "Attorneys") for Fiscal Year**  
4 **2002 to provide legal representation with respect to certain of the Nation's water**  
5 **matters; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract expired on September 30, 2002; and**

7 **WHEREAS, continued representation regarding water matters is required to protect the Nation's**  
8 **interests; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Operating Budget for the Office of Attorney General for Fiscal Year 2003, as**  
10 **approved by the Legislative Council in Resolution No. 02-427, has sufficient funds for**  
11 **an Attorney Contract in the amount of \$15,000 for representation in these matters;**  
12 **and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Attorney General has proposed an Attorney Contract with the Attorneys in the**  
14 **amount of \$15,000, a copy of which is attached hereto; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee recommends approval by the Legislative Council of**  
16 **an Attorney Contract with the Attorneys on such terms.**

17 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

- 18 **1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves an Attorney Contract**  
19 **with the Attorneys in the amount of \$15,000 for the fiscal year ending September**  
20 **30, 2003 and in the form attached hereto.**
- 21 **2. Funding for the Attorney Contract shall be provided under the authority of**  
22 **Resolution No. 02-427 from the Operating Budget of the Office of Attorney General**  
23 **(01-1031-810).**
- 24 **3. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute the Attorney**  
25 **Contract.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
27 **of NOVEMBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,333.85 FOR; 83.65**  
28 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
29 **Section 2 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
30 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
31 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
32 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**






