

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Acceptance of No-Cost Grant Extension for the Tohono O'odham Nation**  
**Pesticide Program)**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-545

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation utilizes pesticides as the tribal farms and hires  
2 commercial applicators to apply pesticides within the tribal building, community,  
3 homes, schools, and business establishments; and

4 WHEREAS, potential safety and environmental issues may exist due to the pesticide applications;  
5 and

6 WHEREAS, the United States Environmental Protection Agency has provided funding in a  
7 Cooperative Agreement #E-98911602-1 to assist the Nation in addressing these issues;  
8 and

9 WHEREAS, the original project period was March 1, 2001 to September 30, 2002; and

10 WHEREAS, the USEPA has recommended that continued funding for the Pesticide Program come  
11 from GAP funding; and

12 WHEREAS, there will be a delay during this funding transition; and

13 WHEREAS, there is \$19,086.01 in savings to continue the program until the transition can be  
14 completed; and

15 WHEREAS, the EPA, Region IX granted an extended project period to be October 1, 2002 to March  
16 31, 2003.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby  
18 approves the attached No-Cost Extension.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, the Chairman is  
20 authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any  
21 amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted  
22 for further prior approval.

23 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Pesticide Program is authorized to expend funds from this No-  
24 Cost Extension beginning October 1, 2002 to March 31, 2003.

25 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07<sup>TH</sup>. Day  
26 of NOVEMBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-  
27 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
28 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
29 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
30 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
31 Stat. 984).
