

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving Amendment to the Gu-Vo District FY 01 Supplement Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 02-551**

1 **WHEREAS, the Gu Vo District experienced a very serious incident that saddened all the District**  
2 **membership; and**

3 **WHEREAS, on October 20, 2002, one of the Security guards was shot to death on duty; and**

4 **WHEREAS, this incident prompted the Gu-Vo District Administration to request three (3)**  
5 **additional Security to ensure that two (2) Security be on duty each shift; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the District Administration met with the District's Budget & Finance Committee to**  
7 **seek and modify funds within the District's Supplement Budget; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Gu-Vo District Governing Council are in agreement of creating three new line**  
9 **items; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the FY 2001 Supplement Budget will cover the cost of two new Security positions, as**  
11 **well as, equipment; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the balance of the District's Supplement budget will be amended into the new line**  
13 **items:**

610 Salaries	620 Fringe Benefits
721 Supplies Other	

16 **for the two (2) additional Security, as well, as new equipment for the District's Security**  
17 **Guards.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council are in**  
19 **agreement of establishing three (3) new line items to the Gu-Vo District Supplement**  
20 **Budget.**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves that the Gu-Vo**  
22 **District Supplement Budget's balance in the amount of Fifty thousand, seven hundred**  
23 **fifty-eight 6 0/100 dollars (\$50,758.60) be modified into the new items for said**  
24 **purposes.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08<sup>TH</sup>. Day**  
26 **of NOVEMBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,914.8 FOR; -0-**  
27 **AGAINST; 160.7 NOT VOTING; and 342.0[09] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**  
28 **by Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by**  
29 **the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
