7		seek and modify funds within the District's Supplement Budget; and					
8	WHEREAS,	the Gu-Vo District Governing Council are in agreement of creating three new line					
9		items; and					
10	WHEREAS,	the FY 2001 Supplement Budget will cover the cost of two new Security positions, as					
11		well as, equipment; and					
12	WHEREAS,	the balance of the District's Supplement budget will be amended into the new line					
13		items:

16		for the two (2) additional Security, as well, as new equipment for the District's Security
