

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Refer the Baboquivari District's position on Per Diem and Travel Dollars owed**  
**to the Nation to the Rules Committee and Legislative Branch Administration**  
**Officers for discussion)**

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 02-553

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did convene on November 08, 2002 for its**  
2 **regularly scheduled session, and its agenda did include a presentation from the**  
3 **Baboquivari District on its position on Per Diem and Travel Dollars owed to the**  
4 **Nation; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Baboquivari District Vice Chairman did present District Council Resolution No.**  
6 **02-B-55 entitled, "Directing the Repayment of Travel and Per-Diem Expenses**  
7 **Incurred by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council and Staff for Fiscal Years 1998-**  
8 **2002," whereby the Baboquivari District directed that Legislative Branch Officers**  
9 **seek reimbursement of monies owed; and**

10 **WHEREAS, questions were raised with regard to language contained in the proposed draft**  
11 **resolution submitted by Baboquivari District, specifically the district's authority to**  
12 **direct Branch officers to take certain steps to collect monies owed, as well as other**  
13 **questions regarding record keeping and adjusted amounts, if any, made in the**  
14 **interim; and**


15 **WHEREAS, a motion was made to refer this matter to the Rules Committee and Legislative**  
16 **Branch Administration Officers for further discussion.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**  
18 **refers the matter of the Baboquivari District's position on Per Diem and Travel**  
19 **Dollars owed to the Nation to the Rules Committee and Legislative Branch**  
20 **Administration Officers for further discussion and resolution.**

21 **BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that a report and resolution on the matter be presented during**  
22 **the December 2002 General Session.**

23 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08<sup>TH</sup> Day of**  
24 **NOVEMBER 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,075.5 FOR; -0-**  
25 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 342.0 [09] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
26 **Section 1 (I) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
27 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
28 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
29 **Stat. 984).**
