

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving a Tribal-State Gaming Compact)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 02-561**

1 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 02-539, the Legislative Council accepted the recommendation of the**  
2 **Nation's Gaming Negotiating Committee to approve the new standard form of tribal-**  
3 **state gaming compact set forth in Proposition 202 and directed the Nation's**  
4 **Chairman, upon passage of Proposition 202, to timely execute on behalf of the**  
5 **Tohono O'odham Nation a new standard form of tribal-state gaming compact; and**

6 **WHEREAS, Proposition 202 was approved by a majority of the Arizona voters at the November 5,**  
7 **2002 election; it will become effective upon proclamation by the Governor of Arizona**  
8 **which will occur on or after November 25, 2002; and**

9 **WHEREAS, Section 17 of the Proposition 202 standard form of tribal-state gaming compact**  
10 **requires the Nation and the State to negotiate in good faith within 180 days of the**  
11 **effective date of the compact proposed amendments to certain enumerated**  
12 **regulatory provisions of the compact; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Governor of Arizona has proposed addressing the Section 17 regulatory**  
14 **provisions of the compact at this time so that those provisions may be included in the**  
15 **compact prior to execution, thereby avoiding subsequent amendment; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Governor's authority under state law to enter into new or amended tribal-state**  
17 **gaming compacts continues to be challenged by the racetracks in both state court**  
18 **and federal court; and**


19 **WHEREAS, it is in the Nation's interest to execute a new or amended tribal-state gaming compact**  
20 **at the earliest opportunity.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

- 22 **1. The Legislative Council authorizes and directs the Nation's Chairman to timely**  
23 **request on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation a new standard form of tribal-**  
24 **state gaming compact in the form set forth in Proposition 202.**
- 25 **2. In addition to that grant of authority, the Legislative Council also authorizes the**  
26 **Nation's Gaming Negotiating Committee (with the advice and assistance of the**  
27 **Nation's Gaming Office, Gaming Authority and Office of Attorney General) to: (i)**  
28 **negotiate the regulatory amendments proposed by the Governor of Arizona; (ii)**  
29 **recommend to the Chairman of the Nation whether it is in the best interests of the**  
30 **Nation to enter into a new standard form of tribal-state gaming compact as set**
