

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving the FY 2003 Livestock Facility Hay Sales Revenue Account Acct. #44-1510)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 02-580**

1 **WHEREAS, the Livestock Facility Program is under the direction of the Natural Resources**  
2 **Department; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Program has been responsible for maintaining the use of the**  
4 **facilities; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Livestock Facility is seeking ways and means to establish the Livestock Complex**  
6 **to its original use; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Livestock Facility Program is approved in Resolution No. 99-204 to expend funds**  
8 **in the revenue fund to pay TOFA for the alfalfa hay sold, to fund the Livestock Yard**  
9 **Attendant, and to fund the service, maintenance and upgrade of the Livestock**  
10 **Complex and Complex equipment; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Livestock Facility Program has proposed a budget for the hay sales program of**  
12 **\$25,000 for the fiscal year 2003.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**  
14 **approves the budget for the hay revenue account in accordance with the budget**  
15 **attached hereto.**

16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that hay for sale and/or supplies be purchased on consignment or with**  
17 **funds on hand from hay sales.**

18 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 03<sup>RD</sup>, Day**  
19 **of DECEMBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-**  
20 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
21 **Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
22 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
23 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
24 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


