


RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Utilization of the Pen Lease proceeds at the Livestock Facility)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-581

- 1 **WHEREAS, the Livestock Facility Program is under the direction of the Natural Resources**
2 **Department; and**
- 3 **WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Program has been responsible for maintaining the use of the**
4 **facilities; and**
- 5 **WHEREAS, the Livestock Facility is seeking ways and means to establish the Livestock Complex**
6 **to its original use; and**
- 7 **WHEREAS, the Livestock Facility has never had an Operational budget; and**
- 8 **WHEREAS, the Livestock Facility Program is approved in Resolution No. 2000-239 for a special**
9 **account for revenue deposits from pen proceeds, Account #44-1519-450; and**
- 10 **WHEREAS, the Livestock Facility Program has proposed a pen lease revenue budget for fiscal**
11 **year 2003 in the amount of \$1,200.00; and**
- 12 **WHEREAS, the Livestock Facility Program will use pen proceeds to purchase supplies and**
13 **materials to maintain the facility and improve services to the livestock owners of the**
14 **Nation.**
- 15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
16 **approves the budget for utilizing the pen proceeds for maintaining the facility and**
17 **improving services to the livestock owners of the Nation approves for pen proceeds**
18 **currently in the account and for pen proceeds paid during the remainder of the fiscal**
19 **year to be used to purchase supplies within the budget allocations as needed.**

20 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 03RD Day**
21 **of DECEMBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-**
22 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
23 **Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
24 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
25 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
26 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
