

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the FY-2003 Solid Waste Management Program Revenue Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-585

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation in exercise of its sovereign authority, desires to manage**
2 **and regulate the storage, collection, recycling, transportation and disposal of solid**
3 **waste and certain hazardous waste on lands within the boundaries of the Nation in**
4 **order to protect the Nation's environment, its natural resources, the political**
5 **integrity and economic security of the Nation, and the health, safety and welfare of**
6 **its members and all persons present on the lands of the Nation; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council adopted the Solid Waste Management Code**
8 **and Solid Waste Management Plan on February 12, 1997 with Resolution No.97-041;**
9 **and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Solid Waste Plan directs the Solid Waste Management Program**
11 **to implement a system of collection, recycling and disposal of solid waste, and certain**
12 **hazardous waste; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Management Plan directs the Solid Waste Management Program to**
14 **collect solid waste fees to help pay for program costs; and**

15 **WHEREAS, Resolution No. 98-236 approves the creation of a dedicated account for the deposit**
16 **of solid waste and recycling fees; and Resolution No. 2000-309 allocates SWMP**
17 **revenue for the purchase of solid waste equipment to meet the growing needs of the**
18 **program and Resolution No. 01-631 allocates additional revenue for equipment**
19 **purchases and to fund the solid waste educator position; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the residential and commercial customers pay for some of the program's costs, and**
21 **the Nation through tribal budget 01-1097 pays for the remainder of the program's**
22 **operational costs; and**

23 **WHEREAS, to provide solid waste collection service to all residents in all villages of the Nation**
24 **additional funds are needed beyond that which is provided in the tribal budget 01-**
25 **1097.**

26 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
27 **authorizes the FY -2003 revenue budget in the amount of \$309,141.91 as detailed in**
28 **the attached budget request.**

29 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 03RD Day**
30 **of DECEMBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-**
31 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
32 **Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
33 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
34 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
35 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


