

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approval of Modification to Grant Agreement 6-FG-32-00100 and Authorization  
to Expend Funds)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 02-590**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation entered into a \$23,374,714.00, four year Public Law 93-**  
2 **638 Grant Agreement with the Bureau of Reclamation, Agreement No. 6-FG-32-00100,**  
3 **with Secretary of the Interior, through the Bureau of Reclamation, for the**  
4 **construction of a distribution system for delivery of Central Arizona Project Water to**  
5 **the Schuk Toak District of the Tohono O'odham Nation in December 1995; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Water Projects Office has already received funds from the Bureau of Reclamation**  
7 **to construct the Schuk Toak Farm Maintenance Facility and completion of this**  
8 **project will be accomplished using the carry over funds from FY 2002; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Water Projects Office could not complete all capital purchases in FY 2002,**  
10 **including two (2) new field vehicles and computer upgrades due to product**  
11 **unavailability and can now be accomplished using carry over funds from FY 2002; and**


12 **WHEREAS, the Water Projects Office has presented this modification to the appropriate**  
13 **committees and the committees wish to bring it before the Legislative Council.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves a**  
15 **Modification to Grant Agreement No. 6-FG-32-00100 in the form attached hereto**  
16 **which budgets for \$1,822,161.53 as the Water Projects Office new FY 2003 Budget and**  
17 **the Legislative Council authorizes the Water Projects Office to expend such funds.**

18 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes and**  
19 **directs the Chairman of the Nation to execute a modification to the current FY 2003**  
20 **budget using funds already included in Grant Agreement 6-FG-32-00100 with no**  
21 **additional funding needed.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04<sup>th</sup>. Day**  
23 **of DECEMBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,089.5 FOR; -0-**  
24 **AGAINST; 328.0 NOT VOTING; and [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
25 **Section 1 (d)(3) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
26 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
27 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
28 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
