

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Re-appointment of Albert Manuel, Jr. to the Arizona Advisory Council on  
Indian Health Care)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 02-601**

1 **WHEREAS, the State of Arizona has created an Advisory Council on Indian Health Care ("Advisory**  
2 **Council") to address the health care needs of American Indians within Arizona; and**

3 **WHEREAS, each Arizona Indian tribe may nominate a member for appointment to the Advisory**  
4 **Council and submit the nomination to the Governor of the State of Arizona; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council Health and Human Services Committee ("HHS Committee")**  
6 **has been delegated authority to consult with tribal, federal, state and local**  
7 **governments, their departments, agencies, or political subdivisions on programs and**  
8 **activities relating to human health and welfare (Plan of Operation for HHS**  
9 **Committee , adopted pursuant to Legislative Order No. 02-093); and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has previously nominated the HHS Committee Chairman**  
11 **for appointment to the Advisory Council; and**

12 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2000-006 and Resolution No. 01-359, the Tohono O'odham Nation**  
13 **nominated and supported the appointment of HHS Committee Chairman Albert**  
14 **Manuel, Jr. to the Advisory Council; and**

15 **WHEREAS, Councilman Manuel's term on the Advisory Council will end on January 15, 2003; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee recommends that its Chairman, Albert**  
17 **Manuel, Jr., be re-appointed to the Advisory Council and requests that the Tohono**  
18 **O'odham Legislative Council support this nomination.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**  
20 **nominate and recommend to the Governor of Arizona that Health and Human**  
21 **Services Committee Chairman Albert Manuel, Jr. be re-appointed to the Advisory**  
22 **Council on Indian Health Care for the term ending January 15, 2005.**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that any appointment made pursuant to this Resolution shall**  
24 **immediately expire if Councilman Manuel vacates his office as a Legislative Council**  
25 **Representative for any reason.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
27 **of DECEMBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,834.1 FOR; 416.1**  
28 **AGAINST; 416.1 NOT VOTING; and 167.3 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**  
29 **by Section 1 (c)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
30 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
31 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
32 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


