

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Calling March 15, 2003 Special Election for Initiative No. IN-03-02, "Adopting Cultural Center/Museum site Legislative Council Resolution No. 2000-275 appropriating \$15,191,080.00 for the construction, staffing and operation of a Cultural Center Museum" as Required by the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation)**

RESOLUTION NO. 03-013

1 **WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 1(g) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation**
2 **("Constitution") vests the Legislative Council with authority "to enact laws and**
3 **ordinances for conducting and regulating elections"; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council did enact the Uniform Election Ordinance ("Election**
5 **Ordinance"), Ordinance No. 03-86, which identifies the roles of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Election Board and the Legislative Council in the initiative process; and**

7 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Article XII of the Election Ordinance, the Election Board has certified that**
8 **Initiative Petition No. IN-03-02, "Adopting Cultural Center/Museum site Legislative**
9 **Council Resolution No. 2000-275 appropriating \$15,191,080.00 for the construction,**
10 **staffing and operation of a Cultural Center Museum" ("Initiative") has received a**
11 **minimum of three hundred valid signatures; and**

12 **WHEREAS, in accordance with Article XII, Section 7(D)(1), of the Election Ordinance, the Election**
13 **Board did (1) notify the Legislative Council Chairwoman of the Petition and Board**
14 **certification on December 20, 2002, (2) file the Petition with the Legislative Council**
15 **on the same date, and (3) request that the Council either adopt the Initiative Measure**
16 **or call a special election within ninety (90) days of receiving the Petition; and**

17 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Article XII, Section 9(A), of the Election Ordinance and Article XV of the**
18 **Constitution, the Legislative Council "shall either adopt the initiative measure by a**
19 **majority vote without alteration or shall call for a special election" to be held not**
20 **later than ninety days after the petition was filed with the council; and**

21 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council did not pass Resolution No. 03-012, which would have adopted**
22 **the Initiative Measure; and**

23 **WHEREAS, the Council is therefore mandated by Article XV of the Constitution to call a special**
24 **election to allow Tohono O'odham Nation members to vote on the Initiative Measure.**

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby calls a**
26 **special election for March 15, 2003 to allow Tohono O'odham Nation members to vote**
27 **on Initiative No. IN-03-02, "Adopting Cultural Center/Museum site Legislative Council**



4 **conducting the special election in accordance with the laws of the Nation.**



6 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH Day**
7 **of JANUARY, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-**
8 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
9 **Section 1 (g) of Article VI and Article XV of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,**
10 **adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
11 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act**
12 **of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
