

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Rescinding Resolution No. 03-018, "Extending Resolution No. 02-593 for FY 2002 Continuing**  
**Authorization for the Special Projects Office for the Period of January 10, 2003**  
**through March 07, 2003" and Adopting Special Projects Office FY 2003 Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 03-029**

- 1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has previously authorized the Special Projects Office to operate**  
2 **after October 1, 2002 pursuant to series of continuing resolutions; and**
- 3 **WHEREAS, on January 7, 2003, the Legislative Council passed Resolution No. 03-018, which further**  
4 **extended Special Projects Office funding at FY 2002 levels, but did not adopt a Special**  
5 **Projects Office FY 2003 Budget; and**
- 6 **WHEREAS, the Special Projects Office has prepared and presented its FY 2003 Budget in the amount**  
7 **of \$266,761.78, which is incorporated by this reference, to the Executive Review, Health**  
8 **and Human Services, and Budget and Finance Committees, but this budget had not been**  
9 **presented to the Legislative Council for action; and**
- 10 **WHEREAS, funds are available in the Reserve Accounts for Early Childhood Head Start, Dialysis**  
11 **Center, and West Side Health Clinic, (as specified in attached Exhibit B which are**  
12 **incorporated by this reference) which may be used to consolidate the Special Projects**  
13 **Office's administrative expense requirements for each project; and**
- 14 **WHEREAS, consolidating the administrative expense requirements for each of the three projects is**  
15 **in the best interest of the Nation, and as of September 30, 2002, \$1,043,817.72 remains**  
16 **available for budgetary purposes amongst all three projects; and**
- 17 **WHEREAS, the Special Projects Office's proposed, consolidated Fiscal Year 2003 Budget requires**  
18 **\$266,761.78 to administer the Westside Health Clinic Project at 40%, the Dialysis Facility**  
19 **Project at 20%, and the Head Start Facilities Project at 40%; and**
- 20 **WHEREAS, it is in the Nation's best interests for the Special Projects Office to be funded for the**  
21 **current fiscal year at the appropriate level and pursuant to a FY 2003 Budget; and**
- 22 **WHEREAS, as the adoption of the Special Projects Office FY 2003 Budget will make Resolution No. 03-**  
23 **018 unnecessary, it may be rescinded.**
- 24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby rescinds**  
25 **Resolution No. 03-018, "Extending Resolution No. 02-593 for FY 2002 Continuing**  
26 **Authorization for the Special Projects Office for the Period of January 10, 2003 through**  
27 **March 07, 2003."**
- 28 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council hereby approves the use of**  
29 **the funds specified from the following reserve accounts to fund the Special Projects Office**  
30 **FY 2003 Budget:**

4 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** the Legislative Council hereby approves and authorizes the  
5                                    **consolidation of expenditures for the projects administered by the Special Projects Office**  
6                                    **according to the Fiscal Year 2003 Budget in the amount of \$266,761.78.**

7 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Special Projects Office FY 2003 Budget shall be  
8                                    **retroactive to October 1, 2002.**

9 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Special Projects Office shall provide project status  
10                                   **reports on a monthly basis to the Health and Human Services and Budget and Finance**  
11                                   **Committees and quarterly basis to the Legislative Council.**


12 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09<sup>TH</sup>. Day**


