

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving & Authorizing Baboquivari District To Submit the Administration for  
Native American (ANA) Social and Economic Development Strategies (SEDS) Grant  
Application)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 03-039**

1 **WHEREAS, the Baboquivari District is planning a community and economic development project**  
2 **within the boundaries of the Baboquivari District; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Baboquivari District by Resolution No. 03-LT-01 did get approval and support by**  
4 **the Artesia-Little Tucson Community where the potential site of the project will be**  
5 **located; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Baboquivari District did also get approval and support by the District Council per**  
7 **Resolution No. 03-B-02; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Baboquivari District is interested and finds that their project meets the eligibility**  
9 **requirements to apply for financial assistance through the Administration for Native**  
10 **American (ANA) Social and Economic Development Strategies (SEDS); and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Administration and Native American (ANA) Social and Economic Development**  
12 **Strategies (SEDS) Grant does have funding available for projects in areas of Social and**  
13 **Economic Development; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Baboquivari District and Economic Development Department and or other**  
15 **entities of the Tohono O'odham Nation will jointly provide in-kind contributions**  
16 **needed to meet the 20% matching requirements for the Administration and Native**  
17 **American (ANA) grant; and**

18 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**  
19 **authorize the Executive Branch to submit on behalf of Baboquivari District an**  
20 **application for financial assistance to the Administration for Native American (ANA)**  
21 **Social and Economic Development Strategies (SEDS).**

22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation is authorized**  
23 **to sign and submit the grant application for Baboquivari District.**

24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Baboquivari District and the Economic Development**  
25 **Department and or other entities of the Tohono O'odham Nation shall provide in-**  
26 **kind contributions to meet the 20% matching requirements for the Administration**  
27 **and Native American (ANA) - (SEDS) financial assistance grant proposal.**

28 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**  
29 **Baboquivari District to apply for the ANA-SEDS financial assistance grant. The**  
30 **district shall be responsible for the furtherance of the Baboquivari District Economic**

1 Development Project, provided that the Tohono O'odham Nation shall not be held  
2 responsible for the obligations of Baboquivari District.


3 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10<sup>th</sup>, Day  
4 of JANUARY, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-  
5 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
6 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
7 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
8 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
9 Stat. 984).


