(Filing Analysis and Arguments Regarding Initiative IN-03-02, "Adopting Cultural Center/
Museum Site Legislative Council Resolution No. 2000-275 appropriating \$15,191,080.00
for the construction, staffing and operation of a Cultural Center Museum")**

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 03-045

- 1 **WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 1(g) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the**
2 **Legislative Council with authority "to enact laws and ordinances for conducting and**
3 **regulating elections"; and**
- 4 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council did enact the Uniform Election Ordinance ("Election**
5 **Ordinance"), Ordinance No. 03-86, which identifies the roles of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Election Board and the Legislative Council in the initiative process; and**
- 7 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Article XII of the Election Ordinance, the Election Board has certified that**
8 **Initiative Petition No. IN-03-02, "Adopting Cultural Center/Museum site Legislative**
9 **Council Resolution No. 2000-275 appropriating \$15,191,080.00 for the construction,**
10 **staffing and operation of a Cultural Center Museum" ("Initiative") has received a**
11 **minimum of three hundred valid signatures; and**
- 12 **WHEREAS, based upon the Election Board's certification, the Legislative Council has called a**
13 **special election for March 15, 2003 to allow the Nation's voters to consider the**
14 **Initiative; and**
- 15 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Article XII, Section 11(B), of the Election Ordinance,**
16 **"Not later than sixty (60) days preceding the election the council, after providing**
17 **reasonable opportunity for comments by all representatives, shall prepare and file**
18 **with the Election Board an analysis of the provisions of each ballot proposal of a**
19 **measure together with a list of popular arguments favoring and opposing each**
20 **proposal. Each argument favoring and opposing each such proposal shall not exceed**
21 **three hundred (300) words in length"; and**
- 22 **WHEREAS, Legislative Council representatives were given a reasonable opportunity to make**
23 **such comments; and**
- 24 **WHEREAS, the Rules Committee, in cooperation with the Legislative Chairwoman and Vice**
25 **Chairman, has developed the attached analysis of and arguments for and against the**
26 **Initiative, which are hereby incorporated by this reference; and**
- 27 **WHEREAS, the Council's preparation and filing of the attached analysis and arguments as**
28 **mandated by the Election Ordinance does not constitute support for or opposition to**
29 **the Baboquivari site.**



1 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
2 **directs the Legislative Secretary to file the attached analysis and arguments**
3 **pertaining to Initiative No. IN-03-02 with the Election Board no later than January**
4 **14, 2003 as required pursuant to Article XII, Section 11(B), of the Election**
5 **Ordinance.**

6 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH Day of**
7 **JANUARY 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,169.4 FOR; 248.1**
8 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
9 **Section 1 (g) of Article VI and Article XV of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,**
10 **adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
11 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act**
12 **of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
