## **RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL** (Accepting Certification of Eligible Members and Authorizing the Initial Expenditure of Funds for Per Capita Payments under the Initiative)

# **RESOLUTION NO.** 03-059

1	WHEREAS,	on June 28, 1997 the voters of the Tohono O'odham Nation (the "Nation") approved
2		Initiative No. IN-01-97 (the "Initiative"); and
3	WHEREAS,	the Initiative authorized funding from Gaming Revenues for several measures,
4		including a one-time per capita distribution of \$2,000 to each member of the Nation
5		enrolled on June 28, 1997 (the "Initial Per Capita Distribution"); and
6	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Resolution 97-451, the Legislative Council adopted an Initiative Funding
7		and Implementation Plan (the "FIP") which authorized the establishment of set-aside
8		accounts for the Initial Per Capita Distribution and other Initiative measures, and set
9		certain conditions on the expenditure of funds from such accounts; and
10	WHEREAS,	by Resolution 97-478, the Legislative Council approved the transfer of funds from the
11		Desert Diamond Savings Account to certain designated set-aside accounts
12		established at Bank of America Arizona, including the sum of \$41.5 million to set-
13		aside account no. 3030425-1067524 for the Initial Per Capita Distribution (the "Per
14		Capita Account"); and
15	WHEREAS,	three of the conditions to expenditure of the Per Capita Account specified in the FIP
16		are (1) approval by the Secretary of the Interior of a per capita distribution plan (the
17		"Revenue Allocation Plan") pursuant to the requirements of the Indian Gaming
18		Regulatory Act, 25 U.S.C. § 2710 (b) (3); (2) acceptance by the Legislative Council of a
19		Certification of Eligible Members submitted by the Enrollment Office and based upon
20		receipt of a properly completed and filed Certificate of Eligibility Verification for Per
21		Capita Payment for each member; and (3) as to each Minor Eligible Member,
22		establishment of a restricted account at Bank of America for deposit of such
23		member's per capita payment; and
24	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Resolution 97-452, the Legislative Council adopted a Revenue Allocation
25		Plan and caused the Plan to be submitted for approval by the Phoenix Area Office
26		of the Bureau of Indian Affairs in accordance with authority delegated to the
27		Area Office by the Secretary of the Interior; and
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- WHEREAS, by letter dated December 18, 1997, the Area Office approved the Revenue Allocation
   Plan with respect to the Initial Per Capita Distribution and disapproved the Plan with
   respect to the Biennial Per Capita Payments; and
- 4 WHEREAS, an agreement with Bank of America has not yet been finalized for the establishment 5 of the restricted accounts which is required as a condition to disbursement of the 6 Initial Per Capita Distribution to such accounts for Minor Eligible Members; and 7 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution Nos. 97-525, 98-010, 98-037, 98-084, 98-128, 98-192, 98-207, 98-8 278, 98-316, 98-360, 98-431, 98-478, 98-505, 99-006, 99-041, 99-081, 99-142, 99-201, 99-9 312, 99-363, 99-422, 99-478, 99-563, 99-635, 2000-005, 2000-037, 2000-085, 2000-148, 10 2000-177, 2000-225, 2000-299, 2000-356, 2000-399, 2000-488, 2000-527, 2000-555, 01-11 005, 01-051, 01-096, 01-136, 01-185, 01-357, 01-418, 01-450, 01-498, 01-545, 02-005, 02-12 044, 02-076, 02-138, 02-182, 02-243, 02-335, 02-371, 02-465, 02-510, 02-571 and 03-005 the Legislative Council accepted and approved Certifications of Eligible Members for 13 14 the Initial Per Capita Distribution, and disbursements have been made to such
- 15 members; and
- 16 WHEREAS, the Enrollment Office has filed with the Legislative Council a Certification of Eligible
   17 Members listing 46 adult members who are eligible for receipt of the Initial Per
   18 Capita Distribution; and
- 19 WHEREAS, all conditions under the laws of the United States and the Nation have been satisfied
   20 to permit the disbursement of the Initial Per Capita Distribution to the members
   21 listed in the Certification of Eligible members.
- 22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:
- 231. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts and approves the24Certification of Eligible Members, in the form attached hereto.

  2. The Legislative Council authorizes (a) the transfer of the sum of \$92,000.00 from

5	requirements of federal law.				
6	3. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized to execute such other documents as				
7	may be necessary to implement this Resolution.
