12		makes it essential that all committee members attend; and					
13	WHEREAS,	it is in the best interest of the members of the Tohono O'odham Nation that their					
14		Legislative Council Representatives be accountable for attending standing					
15		committee meetings in order that the people may be adequately represented; and					
16	WHEREAS,	the Rules Committee has developed the attached "Legislative Council Standing					
17		Committee Attendance Procedure," which is incorporated by this reference, to					
18		provide for such accountability and recommends its adoption.
