RESOLUTION NO. 03-109

1 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Legislative Council Resolution No. 2000-515, the Office of the Chairman**
2 **is presently operating KOHN-FM under a grant from the U.S. Department of**
3 **Commerce, National Telecommunications and Information Administration and a**
4 **budget set aside from the Nation's savings account; and**

5 **WHEREAS, any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall be**
6 **submitted for review and approval by the Legislative Council; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the KOHN-FM program has submitted the attached Amendment No. 2, as attached**
8 **and incorporated by this reference; and**


9 **WHEREAS, under Amendment No. 2, certain operational items within the KOHN-FM**
10 **administrative budget (01-3031) are decreased in the cumulative amount of \$16,750**
11 **to fund other operational requirements within the same budget in order to cover the**
12 **costs related to day-to-day administration of the program; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee of the Legislative Council have reviewed and**
14 **approved Amendment No. 2 to the KOHN-FM budget for Fiscal Year 2003.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the**
16 **Amendment No. 2 to the KOHN-FM budget (Account No. 01-3031) as attached and**
17 **incorporated by this reference are hereby approved and authorized.**

18 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04TH Day**
19 **of MARCH, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,256.8 FOR; 160.7**
20 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
21 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
22 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
23 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
24 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
