

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Authorization and Acceptance of USEPA Assistance Amendment No. GA 979224901-1  
in the amount of \$70,162.00, adding Pesticide-related tasks to the GAP Program)**

RESOLUTION NO. 03-110

1 **WHEREAS, Article XVIII of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation sets out the Council's**  
2 **continuing responsibility to assure for all members safe and healthful**  
3 **surroundings; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation utilizes pesticides at the tribal farms and hires**  
5 **commercial applicators to apply pesticides within the tribal building, community**  
6 **homes, schools, and business establishments; and**

7 **WHEREAS, potential safety and environmental issues may exist due to the pesticide application;**  
8 **and**

9 **WHEREAS, the United States Environmental Protection Agency has agreed to provide an**  
10 **additional \$70,162 in Cooperative Agreement No. GA -979224901-1 to add pesticide-**  
11 **related tasks to the Nation's GAP program; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the budget period is December 1, 2002 to September 30, 2003.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, IT BE RESOLVED THAT the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts**  
14 **the \$70,162 provided in Cooperative Agreement Amendment No. GA-979224901-1,**  
15 **adding pesticide-related tasks to the Nation's GAP program.**

16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,**  
17 **provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of**  
18 **the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval.**

19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Legislative Council approves the attached amendment to the**  
20 **GAP grant (Account #11-5118) and authorizes the expenditure of these additional**  
21 **GAP funds in accordance with this amendment beginning December 1, 2002.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
23 **of MARCH, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-**  
24 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
25 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
26 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
27 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
28 **Stat. 984).**


