8		projects that promote education, environmental conservation, cultural preservation,
9		and sustainable economic development that protects the natural and diverse
10		cultural heritage of the Sonoran Desert; and
11	WHEREAS,	the International Sonoran Desert Alliance ("ISDA") in 2000 elected Directors to serve
12		on its board for the next three years; and
13	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council nominated Councilman Alex Ramon to serve on the ISDA
14		Board of Directors for a three (3) year term (Resolution No. 2000-481) and he was
15		elected; and
16	WHEREAS,	Councilman Ramon resigned his Council seat effective October 4, 2002; and
17	WHEREAS,	the Cultural Preservation Committee has conferred and recommends the
18		appointment of Councilman Jerome Joaquin to replace Alex Ramon on the ISDA
19		Board of Directors.
20	NOW, THE	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
21		recommends the appointment Councilman Jerome Joaquin for the remainder of Alexander
