8		Indian Reservation; and
9	WHEREAS,	the allottees will be required to dismiss U.S. v. Tucson and Alvarez v. Tucson, the
10		class action lawsuits filed for the above-mentioned water claims; and
11	WHEREAS,	it is the goal of the SXAA Board that the allottees have an understanding of the

13		a fair settlement of the law suits, and to then determine for themselves if they wish
14		to be part of the plaintiff class that will dismiss the lawsuits; and

16		educating and informing the allottees about the SAWRSA Amendments and to
17		archive the documents related to the Amendments for future reference; and

20		Tohono O'odham Legislative Council; and
