

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the submission of Pathways Manuscripts)**

RESOLUTION NO. 03-124

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is the governing body of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

2 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has always viewed the health and care of the children of the**
3 **Nation as a priority of the Nation; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has passed by Resolution No. 96-026 approving the Nation's**
5 **participation in a five year Pathway Full scale to prevent Early Onset of diabetes in**
6 **school children funded by the National Heart/lung and Blood Institute; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation in partnership with the Gila River Indian Community**
8 **and the University of Arizona has been an active participant in the "Obesity**
9 **Prevention in American Children" project; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation when asked permission to do so by all interested parties**
11 **will share the result of this project with other Indian Communities and researchers**
12 **from other universities of which data will remain sole proprietorship of the Nation;**
13 **and**

14 **WHEREAS, manuscripts entitled:**

- 15 **1. School Climate Assessment and findings from the Pathways Study.**
- 16 **2. The effects of the Pathways Obesity Prevention Program on Physical Activity in**
17 **American Indian Children.**
- 18 **3. Impact of a School Based Obesity Prevention Program on body composition,**
19 **physical activity, dietary intake and behavior in American Indian Children: the**
20 **Pathways study describing part of the obesity prevention in American Children**
21 **project conducted in part in the Tohono O'odham Nation.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and**
23 **endorses the submittal of these three (3) manuscripts to scientific journals for**
24 **consideration of publication.**

25 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the data collected will remain sole proprietorship of the Tohono**
26 **O'odham Nation.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH Day**
28 **of MARCH, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,750.85 FOR; 419.0**
29 **AGAINST; 247.65 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
30 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
31 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
32 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
33 **Stat. 984).**


