

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Request for Funding for the Design and Construction of Housing for the Westside Health Center)

RESOLUTION NO. 03-133

1 WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 01-071, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did accept and
2 support the proposal for the Joint Venture Construction Program with the U.S. Indian
3 Health Service ("IHS") for a Westside Health Center; and

4 WHEREAS, as reflected in the IHS Program Justification Document (Quarters) ("PJDQ"), the IHS
5 determined that 27 non-local staff will be necessary to support the Westside Health
6 Center when it is fully staffed; and

7 WHEREAS, the IHS and the Health and Human Services Committee and the Appropriations
8 Committee of the Legislative Council recognize that staff quarters will be necessary
9 to recruit, house, and retain staff essential for the start up and operation of the
10 Westside Health Center; and

11 WHEREAS, staff housing may be self-supporting from revenues generated from rental fees; and

12 WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 99-444, \$9.2 million in funds were appropriated by the Nation for the
13 design and construction of the Westside Health Center, yet staff housing was not
14 included; and

15 WHEREAS, the IHS PJDQ estimated that construction of staff housing would cost \$4,952,000; and

16 WHEREAS, the Nation does not have funds for the construction of staff housing for the Westside
17 Health Center.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby requests
19 that the U.S. Congress appropriate \$4,952,000 for FY 2005 for the purpose of
20 constructing staff housing for the Westside Health Clinic as part of the Joint Venture
21 Construction Program.

22 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12TH Day
23 of MARCH, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-
24 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
25 Section 1 (j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
26 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
27 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
28 Stat. 984).




