

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Request for Allocation of Funding for the Water Resources Study Program Continuation
Under Public Law 93-638 Grant for a Comprehensive Water Study for FY 2005)

RESOLUTION NO. 03-135

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation (Nation) entered into a Grant Agreement with the United
2 States Department of Interior, Bureau of Reclamation (BOR), Phoenix Area office
3 under the Indian Self Determination and Education Assistance Act, Public Law 93-638,
4 for the purpose of conducting a comprehensive water inventory of the Nation,
5 designated an Agreement No. 98-FG-32-00800 (Grant Agreement); and

6 WHEREAS, the term of the Grant Agreement had been extended for one (1) year beginning on
7 October 1, 2002 and expiring on September 30, 2003; and

8 WHEREAS, the Program will have completed approximately 60% of the water quality and quantity
9 inventory study for the Tohono O'odham Nation by the end of fiscal year FY 2003; and

10 WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program (Program) has a budget for FY 2003 in the amount
11 of \$1,253,150.40, however there is only money enough left in the savings for the
12 program to continue through FY 2004; and


13 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Water Resources Study Program has submitted an appropriation
14 request in the amount of \$3,770,000 to permit the Program to complete the water
15 quality and quantity inventory study; and

16 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Chairman has provided a letter of support to the
17 Program, to aid the Program with these efforts.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby
19 requests appropriation in the amount of \$3,770,000 for FY 2005 for the Water
20 Resources Study Program, to permit the Program to complete the water quality and
21 quantity inventory study for the Tohono O'odham Nation.

22 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12TH Day
23 of MARCH, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,165.9 FOR; 188.3
24 AGAINST; 896.0 NOT VOTING; and 167.3 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
25 by Section 1 (j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
26 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
27 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
28 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
