1	whereas, the ronono o'odnam Nation (Nation) entered into a Grant Agreement with the United
2	States Department of Interior, Bureau of Reclamation (BOR), Phoenix Area office
3	under the Indian Self Determination and Education Assistance Act, Public Law 93-638,
4	for the purpose of conducting a comprehensive water inventory of the Nation,
5	designated an Agreement No. 98-FG-32-00800 (Grant Agreement); and
6	WHEREAS, the term of the Grant Agreement had been extended for one (1) year beginning on
7	October 1, 2002 and expiring on September 30, 2003; and
8	WHEREAS, the Program will have completed approximately 60% of the water quality and quantity
9	inventory study for the Tohono O'odham Nation by the end of fiscal year FY 2003; and
10	WHEREAS,theWaterResourcesStudyProgram(Program)has a budget for FY 2003 in the amount
11	of \$1,253,150.40, however there is only money enough left in the savings for the
12	program to continue through FY 2004; and
13	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odhamWater Resources Study Program has submitted an appropriation
14	request in the amount of \$3,770,000 to permit the Program to complete the water
15	quality and quantity inventory study; and
16	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Chairman has provided a letter of support to the
17	Program, to aid the Program with these efforts.
18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby
19	requests appropriation in the amount of \$3,770,000 for FY 2005 for the Water
20	Resources Study Program, to permit the Program to complete the water quality and
21	quantity inventory study for the Tohono O'odham Nation.
