2	priority ranking process for the Nation's FY 2005 Federal Appropriations Request; and						
3	WHEREAS, Economic Development was one area where appropriation requests were solicited						
4	from the Executive Branch departments; and						
5	WHEREAS, the Economic Development Department has formulated a four part program directed						
6	at supporting and expanding the private sector of the Nation's economy; and						
7	WHEREAS, the request, entitled "Support for the Private Sector Economy of the Tohono O'odham						
8	Nation", complies with the terms of the Nation's Economic Development Plan adopted						
9	by the Nation and by a majority of the Nation's Districts; and						
10	WHEREAS, the proposed support program will provide services that are desperately needed to						
11	support and expand the Nation's private sector, but which are not currently available						
12	because of a lack of funding; and						
13	WHEREAS, the proposed support program will provide the opportunity to leverage, multiply and						
14	enhance funding provided by Federal, State, private programs, and the Nation's own						
15	resources; and						
16	WHEREAS, the proposed support program will also have a positive impact on the economies of						
17	the region and the surrounding non-O'odham communities in Southern Arizona.						
18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation that						
19	the Council requests FY 2005 federal appropriation of \$991,000.00 to fund the program						
20	entitled "Support for the Private Sector Economy of the Tohono O'odham Nation" as						
21	submitted by the Economic Development Department.
