

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 2005 Federal Appropriation Request for Economic Development Entitled,
"Support for the Private Sector Economy of the Tohono O'odham Nation")**

RESOLUTION NO. 03-136

1 **WHEREAS, the Appropriations Committee solicited appropriation requests to be included in the**
2 **priority ranking process for the Nation's FY 2005 Federal Appropriations Request; and**
3 **WHEREAS, Economic Development was one area where appropriation requests were solicited**
4 **from the Executive Branch departments; and**
5 **WHEREAS, the Economic Development Department has formulated a four part program directed**
6 **at supporting and expanding the private sector of the Nation's economy; and**
7 **WHEREAS, the request, entitled "Support for the Private Sector Economy of the Tohono O'odham**
8 **Nation", complies with the terms of the Nation's Economic Development Plan adopted**
9 **by the Nation and by a majority of the Nation's Districts; and**
10 **WHEREAS, the proposed support program will provide services that are desperately needed to**
11 **support and expand the Nation's private sector, but which are not currently available**
12 **because of a lack of funding; and**
13 **WHEREAS, the proposed support program will provide the opportunity to leverage, multiply and**
14 **enhance funding provided by Federal, State, private programs, and the Nation's own**
15 **resources; and**
16 **WHEREAS, the proposed support program will also have a positive impact on the economies of**
17 **the region and the surrounding non-O'odham communities in Southern Arizona.**
18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation that**
19 **the Council requests FY 2005 federal appropriation of \$991,000.00 to fund the program**
20 **entitled "Support for the Private Sector Economy of the Tohono O'odham Nation" as**
21 **submitted by the Economic Development Department.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12TH, Day**
23 **of MARCH, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,486.9 FOR; 254.85**
24 **AGAINST; 675.75 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
25 **Section 1 (j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
26 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
27 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
28 **Stat. 984).**


