2	population of over 25,000 people who are widely dispersed throughout the four							
3	separated reservation lands; and							
4	WHEREAS,the Tohono O'odham Nation is largely dependent on quality training and education							
5	of its membership which is also dependent on appropriated funding; and							
6	WHEREAS, economic development on the Nation hinges on the ability of the educational system							
7	to provide a pool of people with the expertise that will enable them to be contributors							
8	to their Nation's governance and economic future; and							
9	WHEREAS, the basic budget for the ${f Employment}$ Assistance ${f Program}$ is at \$336,576.61 for FY 2003.							
10	However, the amount continues to be inadequate to meet the demands of the							
11	population serviced; and							
12	WHEREAS, 'the Tohono O'odham Nation Education Department has submitted an appropriation							
13	request to expand services provided under the existing program of the Employment							
14	Assistance Program in the amount of \$318,599.54.							
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does hereby							
16	urgently request that Congress fully fund its appropriations for the Employment							
17	Assistance Program for the Tohono O'odham Nation in the total amount of \$655,176.15							
18	for FY 2005.
