

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Support of the Tohono O'odham Nation Veterans Memorial Monument and Park
Appropriations Request for FY 2005)**

RESOLUTION NO. 03-140

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham men and women have served in all branches of the armed force
2 in peace time and in combat dating back to World War I to the current Afghanistan
3 War; and

4 WHEREAS, American Indians have served in the Armed Forces of the United States at a higher per
5 capita rate than any other minority ethnic group; and

6 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has approved a land site in Sells, Arizona that was given
7 to the Tohono O'odham Veterans by the late Chairman Josiah Moore of the Tohono
8 O'odham Nation to build a Veterans Memorial Park; and

9 WHEREAS, there is a need for a Veterans Memorial Monument to honor all who made the
10 Supreme Sacrifice; and

11 WHEREAS, there is a need for a new Veterans Memorial Park where the Veterans Memorial
12 Monument can be placed; and

13 WHEREAS, the Veterans Affairs office recently received \$50,000.00 from the United States
14 Veterans Affairs Office and the Housing and Urban Development to be utilized for
15 expenses to build a Veterans Memorial Monument and Park within the Tohono
16 O'odham Nation; and

17 WHEREAS, with the \$50,000.00, the Veterans Memorial Park still lacks funds to build and complete
18 the Veterans Memorial Monument and Park.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby calls
20 upon Congress and the White House to set appropriate funding in the amount of
21 \$217,600.00 for the Veterans Memorial Monument and Park fund.

22 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12TH Day
23 of MARCH, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-
24 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
25 Section 1 (j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
26 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
27 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
28 Stat. 984).






