

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 2005 Appropriations Priority Listing)**

RESOLUTION NO. 03-142

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council establishes priorities annually for
2 consideration by Congress during its Appropriations hearings; and

3 WHEREAS, the Legislative Appropriations Committee recommends the establishment of top
4 priorities based on the needs and type of services provided to the people; and

5 WHEREAS, the Legislative Appropriations Committee has established two areas as the top
6 priorities for consideration by Congress during the FY 2005 appropriations process.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby
8 adopts the following appropriations priority ranking for FY 2005 and respectfully
9 urges the United States Congress to appropriate such funds as necessary to increase
10 the two areas to an exemplary level of funding:

- 11 1. Health 2. Law Enforcement


12 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12TH Day
13 of MARCH, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,969.55 FOR; 188.3
14 AGAINST; 259.65 NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
15 Section 1 (j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
16 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
17 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
18 Stat. 984).




