## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Authorizing Application to the Administration for Native Americans Language Preservation Implementation Grant for the Venito Garcia Library and Archives)

RESOLUTION NO. 03-148

1	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has historically supported the Venito Garcia				
2	Library and Archives, the library agency for the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Early				
3	Childhood Division of the Tohono O'odham Education Department; and				
4	WHEREAS, the Venito Garcia Library and Archives, as a part of the Tohono O'odham Education				
5	Department, is a "center for the development and publication of bilingual materials"				
6	mandated by the long-range Tohono O'odham education plan currently in effect				
7	(Comprehensive Education Plan for the O'odham Tribe, passed by the Legislative				
8	Council in 1982); and				
9	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Education Department is charged by the long-range education				
10	plan currently in effect to "coordinate the development and implementation of				
11	bilingual programs in all O'odham schools" and to establish a policy of "supporting				
12	and encouraging bilingual education in O'odham schools"; and				
13	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the Venito Garcia Library and				
14	Archives' application for the Administration for Native Americans Language				
15	Preservation Implementation Grant to produce multimedia courseware reflecting the				
16	major dialect division.				
17	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the				
18	Venito Garcia Library and Archives to apply for a Language Preservation				
19	Implementation Grant from the Administration for Native Americans for the				
20	approximate amount of \$237,782.55, reflecting an annual requested budget of				
21	\$79,260.85 for three (3) years.
