

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Supporting Grant Proposal for Vocational Rehabilitation Services for American  
Indians with Disabilities 121 Project)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 03-149**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council recognizes the need for vocational**  
2 **rehabilitation services to enhance the quality of life for people with disabilities on the**  
3 **Nation; and**


4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is committed to enhancing the level of**  
5 **service to members of the Tohono O'odham Nation who due to a disability may face**  
6 **additional challenges in obtaining and maintaining employment; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Education Department submits this proposal to the**  
8 **Rehabilitation Services Administration Vocational Rehabilitation Service Projects**  
9 **for American Indians with Disabilities to secure funding for a second five-year period**  
10 **(60 months, beginning October 01, 2003 to September 30, 2008), with a funding**  
11 **request of \$400,000 per year with a 10% in-kind match from the Nation, which will**  
12 **assist enrolled Tohono O'odham Nation members with disabilities living on or near**  
13 **the Nation, and other federally recognized Native American with disabilities living on**  
14 **the Nation to develop and maintain meaningful employment.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the**  
16 **Education Department's grant proposal beginning October 01, 2003 to September 30,**  
17 **2008, funding the Tohono O'odham Nation Vocational Rehabilitation Program and**  
18 **authorizes the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation to sign the proposal and**  
19 **submit the necessary documents and assurances to accompany the proposal.**

20 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
21 **of MARCH, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-**  
22 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
23 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
24 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
25 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
26 **Stat. 984).**




