RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Approving Limited Waiver of Sovereign Immunity in Tohono O'odham Farming Authority 2003 Financing Arrangements)

RESOLUTION NO. 03-157

1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Farming Authority ("TOFA") has negotiated with ACCO Finance
2		Co. ("AFC") amendments to:
3		(1) the TOFA Multiple Year Revolving Line of Credit Loan Agreement, executed on
4		November 27, 2000, in the amount of \$3,166,143, as amended on December 3,
5		2002, February 6, 2003, and March, 2003 ("Crop Loan Agreement"), and the related
6		TOFA Multiple Year Revolving Secured Promissory Note; and
7		(2) the TOFA Multiple Year Revolving Line of Credit Loan Agreement, executed on
8		November 27, 2000, in the amount of \$300,000 and as amended on April 25, 2002
9		("Vegetable Loan Agreement") , and the related TOFA Multiple Year Revolving
10		Secured Promissory Note; and
11	WHEREAS,	as amended, the Crop Loan Agreement and the Vegetable Loan Agreement will
12		require that TOFA execute the attached Anderson-Clayton Business Agreement with
13		Anderson Clayton Corp. related to ginning of seed cotton grown by TOFA during the
14		2003-2004 crop year (the "Business Agreement"); and
15	WHEREAS,	as amended, the Crop Loan Agreement, Vegetable Loan Agreement, and the Business
16		Agreement each contain a limited waiver of TOFA's sovereign immunity with respect
17		to disputes arising thereunder; and
18	WHEREAS,	as amended, the Crop Loan Agreement and the Vegetable Loan Agreement require
19		that TOFA deliver to ACF the attached Non-Disturbance and Subordination
20		Agreement (the "Non-Disturbance Agreement") executed by the Nation and including
21		the terms set out in the attached document; and
22	WHEREAS,	on December 5, 2000, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") Legislative Council
23		adopted the attached Resolution No. 2000-559, which approved limited waivers of the
24		sovereign immunity as provided in the Crop Loan Agreement, Vegetable Loan
25		Agreement, and the Business Agreement, and authorized the Nation's Chairman or
26		Vice Chairman to execute the Non-Disturbance Agreement; and
27	WHEREAS,	the amendments to the Crop Loan Agreement and Vegetable Loan Agreement do not
28		amend the provisions with respect to the limited waivers of sovereign immunity; and

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1	WHEREAS,	the Business Agreement for the 2003-2004 crop year is substantially similar to the
2		agreement TOFA executed in 2000; and
3	WHEREAS,	the Non-Disturbance Agreement for the 2003-2004 crop year is substantially similar
4		to the agreement the Nation's Legislative Council authorized the Nation's Chairman
5		or Vice Chairman to execute in Resolution 2000-559; and
6	WHEREAS,	subparagraph 9.2.2(A) of the TOFA's Second Restated Plan of Operation requires
7		approval by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council for waivers of sovereign
8		immunity in connection with crop production and related financing; and
9	WHEREAS,	in TOFA Board Resolution, "Recommending and Requesting Tohono O'odham Nation
10		Legislative Council Action and Authorizing Execution of Amendments to TOFA-ACCO
11		Financing Documents and of Related Documents," the Management Board of TOFA
12		recommended and requested the Nation's approval of the limited waivers of
13		sovereign immunity in the Crop Loan Agreement and Vegetable Loan Agreement, as
14		amended, and the Business Agreement, as amended and requested that the Nation
15		authorize the Chairman or the Vice Chairman of the Nation to execute the Non-
16		Disturbance Agreement; and
17	WHEREAS,	the Agriculture Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee recommend
18		approval by the Nation Legislative Council of the limited waivers of sovereign
19		immunity in the Crop Loan Agreement, Vegetable Loan Agreement, as amended, and
20		the Business Agreement, as amended and recommend that the Nation Legislative
21		Council authorize the Chairman or Vice Chairman to execute the Non-Disturbance
22		Agreement.
23	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:
24		1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the limited waivers of the
25		sovereign immunity as provided in the Crop Loan Agreement and Vegetable
26		Loan Agreement, as amended, and the Business Agreement, as amended.
27		2. The Chairman of the Nation or, in his absence, the Vice Chairman of the Nation,
28		is authorized and directed to execute the Non-Disturbance Agreement in
29		substantially the form and on the terms set forth in the attached Non-
30		Disturbance Agreement.
