

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Reauthorizing Drought Relief Funds from Tucson Electric Power and Authorizing  
Expenditure of Funds)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 03-158**

1 **WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Nation declared a State of Drought and Fire Emergency on May 30,**  
2 **2002; and**

3 **WHEREAS, in response, Tucson Electric Power very generously donated \$15,000 by check dated**  
4 **July 2002 to assist the Tohono O'odham Nation in drought relief efforts; and**

5  
6 **WHEREAS, the Office of the Chairman prepared a budget for expenditure of the TEP funds, and**  
7 **this budget was accepted by the Legislative Council via Resolution No. 02-328; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Nation set up an account for expenditure of these funds of which \$2,941.31 was**  
9 **spent and the remainder of \$12,058.69 was unspent at the end of Fiscal Year 2002; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Nation is anticipating drought conditions this summer, and the funds of \$12,058.69**  
11 **remaining unspent at the close of Fiscal Year 2002 could help programs respond to the**  
12 **drought this summer.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**  
14 **reauthorizes the expenditure of \$12,058.69 remaining of the original TEP donation of**  
15 **\$15,000 and authorizes the Chairman of the Nation to expend the funds according to**  
16 **the attached budget.**

17 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
18 **of APRIL, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
19 **-0- NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2)**  
20 **of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**  
21 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**  
22 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
