

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 2003 Department of the Interior/Bureau of Indian Affairs Budgets)

RESOLUTION NO. 03-160

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has historically contracted certain functions from the**
2 **Bureau of Indian Affairs; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council approved Resolution No. 96-281, the Master Contract (No.**
4 **1450CTH54T61071), between the Tohono O'odham Nation and the U.S. Department of**
5 **Interior ("DOI"), and as extended by Resolution Nos. 99-342 and 02-261 as amended,**
6 **expired on September 30, 2002, and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Executive Branch developed approval of the following budgets as attached and**
8 **incorporated by this reference, to be effective October 1, 2002 through September 30,**
9 **2003 and request authorization to expend the funds:**

12 **of APRIL, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
13 **160.7 NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f)**
14 **of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
15 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
16 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


