

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the Employment & Training Program PY 03/FY 04 Budgets/Comprehensive Service Plan)

RESOLUTION NO. 03-161

1 **WHEREAS, the Department of Labor - Comprehensive Service Plan and Budget has been**
2 **developed with current allocation in the amount of \$473,409.00 beginning July 1, 2003**
3 **and ending June 30, 2006; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Department of Labor - Supplemental Youth Service Plan and Budget has been**
5 **developed with current allocation in the amount of \$ 172,404.00 beginning June 1,**
6 **2003 and ending June 30, 2006; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Economic Security - Adult and Youth PY 03 and FY 04**
8 **Budgets have been developed with State suggested allocations in the amount of \$**
9 **230,282.00 with a modification and contract submittal once final allocation figures**
10 **have been received by the program; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Economic Security - Dislocated Worker PY 03 has been**
12 **developed based on current client participation for program services in the amount**
13 **of \$53,000.00 beginning July 1, 2003 and ending June 30, 2004; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services Budget has been developed in the**
15 **amount of \$ 150,868.00 beginning July 1, 2003 and ending June 30, 2005.**

16 **NOW ,THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**
17 **approve the Employment & Training Budgets/Comprehensive Service Plan and**
18 **Budget PY 2003 in the amount of \$645,813.00 Department of Health and Human**
19 **Services Native Employment Works Budget PY 2003 in the amount of \$150,868.00 and**
20 **Arizona Department of Economic Security WIA and Dislocated Worker program**
21 **PY03/FY04 in the amount of \$283,282 in the combined amount of \$ 1,079,963.00 and**
22 **authorized to incur expenditures upon approval of this resolution.**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
24 **Nation's Officials, to wit; the Chairman is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute**
25 **the contracts and plans, provided however, that any amendment affecting the**
26 **funding or funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for further prior**
27 **approval by this Council.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH Day**
29 **of APRIL, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,256.8 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
30 **160.7 NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (¶)**
31 **of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
32 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
33 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


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


