

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 2003 Department of the Interior/Bureau of Indian Affairs Budgets
Amendment Number One (Amends Resolution No. 03-160))

RESOLUTION NO. 03-173

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation approved Resolution No. 03-160 adopting the Bureau
2 of Indian Affairs budgets with an aggregate total \$12,687,011.77; and

3 WHEREAS, said resolution inadvertently omitted the following program budget:

4 Wildland Program - \$749,289.50 + Est IDC \$94,850.40 = \$844,139.90

5 WHEREAS, resulting in Resolution No. 03-160 requiring an amendment to be adopted by
6 Council in order to allow the Executive Branch to expend said funds.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves
8 the amendment of Resolution No. 03-160 to incorporate and authorize the
9 expenditure of the Wildland budget in the amount of \$749,289.50 + Est IDC
10 \$94,850.40 totaling \$844,139.90.

11 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Executive Branch is hereby authorized to expend a revised total
12 from "\$12,687,011.77" to "\$13,531,151.67" an increase of "\$844,139.90" per attached
13 budget.

14 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH Day
15 of APRIL, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;
16 -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of
17 Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham
18 Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
19 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


