

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(FEMA Grant Extension for purchase of Tender Truck for the Tohono O'odham  
Nation Fire Department, Wildland Fire Management Division)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 03-177**

1 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety/Tohono O'odham Nation Fire Department has taken**  
2 **over Operations of the P.L. 93-638, Wildland Management program from the Bureau**  
3 **of Indian Affairs to provide fire suppression, prevention and the emergency**  
4 **protection of natural and cultural resources and wildlife on the Tohono O'odham**  
5 **Nation; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation"), in exercise of its sovereign authority, desires**  
7 **to manage and regulate the acquisition of additional equipment necessary to provide**  
8 **adequate fire protection to the members of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the FEMA Grant awarded \$158,400.00 for the TONFD to assist with fire protection and**  
10 **safety with a required 10% matching fund of \$17,600; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the original FEMA Grant program period ended August 14, 2002; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Fire Department/Wildland Fire Management Division**  
13 **has received an extension for the period of performance to end May 31, 2003; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the request to approve the FEMA grant extension has been reviewed by the**  
15 **appropriate committees.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
17 **FEMA Grant #EMW-2001-FG-04499 Extension to end May 31, 2003.**

18 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10<sup>TH</sup>. Day**  
19 **of APRIL, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
20 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of**  
21 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**  
22 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**  
23 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
