

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Supporting the Family of Hopi Tribal Member Pfc. Lori Piestewa and All Native
American Veterans and Service Personnel in the United States Armed Forces)**

RESOLUTION NO. 03-185

1 WHEREAS, Native Americans have served in the United States Armed Forces since the
2 Revolutionary War and continue to faithfully serve in the ongoing war against
3 terrorism and the Iraq War; and

4 WHEREAS, a greater percentage of Native Americans have served in the Armed Forces than any
5 other ethnic minority group; and

6 WHEREAS, Pfc. Lori Piestewa, a member of the Hopi Tribe and mother of two young children,
7 volunteered for the United States Army and served with the 507th Maintenance
8 Company; and

9 WHEREAS, on March 23, 2003, members of the 507th were ambushed in Southern Iraq and Pfc.
10 Piestewa was killed.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation joins the Piestewa
12 family and members of the Hopi Tribe in mourning the loss of Pfc. Lori Piestewa.

13 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation offers its continued support to all
14 Native American veterans and service personnel in the United States Armed Forces.

15 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH. Day
16 of APRIL, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;
17 -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) &
18 (l) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
19 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
20 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
21 Stat. 984).


