

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing a Joint Venture Construction Agreement with the U.S. Indian Health Service)

RESOLUTION NO. 03-203

1 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 99-444, funds were appropriated for the design and
2 construction of a health facility for the western lands of the Tohono O'odham Nation
3 (the "Westside Health Facility"); and

4 WHEREAS, the Indian Health Care Improvement Act, Section 818 (e), Public Law ("P.L.") 94-437,
5 25 U.S.C. 1680h(e), as amended by P.L. 102-573, and the Department of Interior and
6 Related Agencies Appropriation Act, 2001, P.L. 106-291, provide for joint venture
7 agreements between the U.S. Indian Health Service ("IHS") and tribal governments;
8 and

9 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 01-071, the Legislative Council accepted and supported a
10 joint venture for the construction of the Westside Health Facility between the Nation
11 and the U.S. Indian Health Service; and

12 WHEREAS, the Nation and the IHS negotiated a proposed Joint Venture Construction Program
13 Agreement (the "Agreement") substantially in the form attached hereto; and


14 WHEREAS, it is in the interests of the Nation for the Westside Health Facility to be constructed
15 under the terms of the Agreement; and

16 WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee recommends approval of the Agreement.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves
18 the Agreement substantially in the form attached hereto.

19 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH Day
20 of MAY, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;
21 -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2)
22 & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
23 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
24 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
25 Stat. 984).


